Week Two: Miriam

VIDEO VIEWER GUIDE

In Matthew 6:9, Jesus teaches us to pray, saying, "_____ be your name."

Miriam is a prime example of praising God for his holy power and might. (Exodus 15).

1st truth:

Put aside your _____.

Don't struggle against the only way that you can really find peace.

2nd truth:

Because He is a great God we can_____.

"yeshuw`ah." -our salvation

*Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.
Psalm 46:10*

3rd truth:

Don't hold back your _____!

*When we remember the power of God who saved us from our sins, how can I not sing his praise?
How can I not adore Him? Friends, let's pray bold with the power of praise.*

It's not that we won't have problems– the problems will come and the pain will be real—but our God will be bigger. He'll fight for us, if we can only be still.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Icebreaker (loosen things up with a lighthearted question):
*Have you ever been in a ridiculous power struggle? (with a toddler or a pet perhaps? Or maybe you were the toddler?)
What happened?*

*Have you ever felt like you were in a power struggle with God?
What happened?*

Hallowing God's name means praising Him. What does power have to do with praise?

Share about an experience that inspired you to praise. What happened?

What stuck out to you during this week of study (this could come from the book or the video)?
