VIDEO VIEWER GUIDE

In Matthew 6:10, Jesus teaches us to pray, saying, “_____ come, your will be done.”

The story of Deborah can help prepare us for our own spiritual battles. (Judges 4-5).

1st truth:

Be _____ ready.

Drive out the idols. Whatever it is that's causing your focus and heart to be led away from God needs to be put firmly in its place.

2nd truth:

Step _____ battle.

In Luke 12 Jesus taught about the foolishness of choosing to seek other things over seeking God's kingdom.

3rd truth:

Our _____ is sweet!

Even though we're still in the throes of battle, we see glimpses of the victory ahead.

When we boldly pray, “God, Your kingdom come” and live like we believe it — readying ourselves for battle and stepping right into the spiritual combat God is calling us to face, then God comes alongside for a victory we wouldn't want to miss!
