VIDEO VIEWER GUIDE	Icebreaker (loosen things up with a lighthearted question): Share one way that God has provided for you unexpectedly.

1st truth: You canto God.

2nd truth: No matter how much we give to God, we can't

3rd truth: God's greatest provision is!
